Over 100 new freshmen applied with only 50 becoming Fresh Hogs. The program is now 2 semesters and has the fresh hogs serving office hours, serving on ASG committees, and acting as senate pages.
 - We use Blackboard for ASG minutes for Cabinet. We also have Cabinet members posing weekly blogs on what they have accomplished. Students may opt into the ASG tab on blackboard.
 - We have created the ASG Ticker to increase transparency of our Student Government. This ticker shows what the Executive officers are doing on typically a daily basis.
